HOW TO STORE UP TREASURE IN HEAVEN

1. I must care about those who suffer

Instead, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. Then, at the resurrection of the godly, God will reward you for inviting those who could not repay you. **Luke 14:12-14 NLT**

GOD COMMANDS US TO CARE ABOUT...

•Hungry, homeless and poor

Share your food with the hungry and open your homes to the homeless poor. Give clothes to those who have nothing to wear. **Is. 58:7 TEV**

•Orphans and widows

What God considers to be pure and genuine religion is this: to take care of orphans and widows in their suffering. **James 1:27 TEV**

•Prisoners

Remember those in prison as if you were their fellow prisoners, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering. **Heb. 13:3 NIV**

•Immigrants

You must show love to foreigners. **Deut. 10:19 NLT**

•Sick and afflicted

You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. **Ezek. 34:4 NIV**


